Liberalism: The False Prophet

Satan's War against God's Morality

I see liberalism as the ideology used by Satan in Satan's on going attempt to remove God's Morality from the minds of Man. As such, Liberalism and its big brother Socialism is the False Prophet, as identified in the Book of Revelations. In the anti-God preaching's of Liberal Dogma, Satan attempts to remove not just the worship of God out of the minds of Man, which is the function of the anti-Christ, but also to destroy the observance of God's Morality from the minds of Man and replace it with Satan's immoral behavior, the following is examples of liberal policies and dogma and their comparison with God's Morality, which gives support and proof of my assertions.

Satan's Purpose

Since the time of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, it has been Satan's purpose to remove from the minds of Man, all that is of God and worshiped. As Satan continues in this endeavor, Satan has begun over the last one hundred or more years to instill in the conscious of Man, a Godless religion, and that religion is Liberalism and its big brother is Socialism. To better demonstrate this I will show you the progression of the forms of Pagan religions over the generations of Man and then I will show how the advocacy of Socialism and Liberalism are in direct opposition to the Morality of God.

In the Beginning

In the beginning of Man on the Earth, after being expelled from the Garden of Eden, Satan established false gods, which took the form of graven images shaped by the hands of men. The gullibility of Man was revealed by their acceptance of these figurines and statues as gods to be worshiped.

With the First Advent of Christ, and Jesus teaching the truth of what God was all about, and who God is, as well as the promises of eternal life, Satan established the False Religion, the anti-Christ as a way of countering the true worship of God that Jesus revealed.

Satan's False Religion is based upon the lies (false gospel) of Satan, even though it still gave lip service to God and Jesus, yet it is void of any acceptance of the First Four of the Ten Commandments; it failed to give worship to God as God commands. This False religion, (the anti-Christ), however, does embrace the morality of God, as reflected in the last Six of the Ten Commandments and the Teachings of Jesus. In this Lie, Satan gave his false religion the look and feel of the true worship of God, which has been accepted as such by a large segment of the human populations since the 300's AD.

Remember: The best told lies are those with 90% truth, and 10% lies. When you fail to teach how to give worship to God as commanded by God, then the worship you give is not of God even though you preach the Morality of God.

Lip Service to God's Morality

Even though the Church of Rome seems to uphold the Morality of God, it really only gives lip service to it. If you are a Catholic, and you commit a sin, you only need to go to a priest, and give confession of your sins, and the priest will give you Absolution.

The word "**Absolution**" is defined as: **release, pardon, and forgiveness**. Think of this act of "**Absolution**" in the same light as the Jews who gave sacrifice to animals at the Temple in their attempts to wash away their sins.

The Way of God

*To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? Saith the Lord: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats. **Isaiah 1:11***

I give you the above verse so you will know what God has to say about the Jews use of the sacrifice of animals, in washing their sins away.

God is asking the question, "**To what purpose, do you do these sacrifices?**" If you sin continually, whereby you must give sacrifice repeatedly, then to what purpose does it do to wash your sins from you, if you are just going to go out and sin again?

Put away the Evil

*Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; learn to do well; seek judgment, relive the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. **Isaiah 1:16-17***

God answers his own question with instruction to those who would give true and correct worship to him. What God is saying is if you are constantly engaging in activities that are sinful, then why should he absolve you of your sins, for you have not learned from your error but continue to do evil. Instead, end your evil ways, and endeavor to do good things that do not require you to have your sins absolved.

If your church tells you that you will have your sins absolved, regardless of how many times you sin, then your church is not teaching you the Way of God, but the way of Satan. To sin is the way of Satan, to live your life as is given in the morality of the Ten Commandments, and taught to us by Jesus, is the Way of God.

Politically Correct

I am not sure if it is true in Europe but in the United States the phrase “**Politically Correct**” has entered into much of our social psyche. I am often scolded by others that I am not Politically Correct, for which I thank them for the compliment. To me it sounds too much like that which the Fascists and Communist forced upon their people during the Twentieth Century; obey what you are told to do, don’t think about it, just do without question.

Liberalism, as it is with its big brother socialism, insists that everyone must adhere to its dictates and ideologies. Those who accept the Liberal ideology have the following mind-set.

If you don't agree with me, then you are wrong, and if you say to others that which is in disagreement to me, then you are a threat, and must be silenced.

Who decides what correct IS?

From the time I first heard the phrase, “**Politically Correct**,” which was long before I began to study scripture, I often wondered who it was that I was in disagreement with. No one could tell me, who it was that first decided what was correct and what was incorrect.

I have always been a conservative in political and economic matters, as well as an entrepreneur and a believer in lightly regulated capitalism, so when the idea of Politically Correct came about, and its correctness was based upon socialist concepts, I naturally rebuked it and those who embraced its dogma.

Once I started my diligent study of God's Holy Word, I found that my objection to Politically Correct wasn't just that I was a political conservative but that **its dogma was in direct opposition to the Morality of God.**

With my understanding of God's True Word, I now know that the reason no one could tell me who it was that first gave definition to what was politically correct, is the same reason all but a handful, are unable see Satan's lies and deceptions for the lies that they are.

If you knew from the beginning that to be politically correct was to be in agreement with Satan's False Gospel, and therefore in opposition to the Word of God, would you have embraced liberalism as strongly as you may have.

Examples of Political Correctness

Discipline of our Children

The following I give as a proof of what I have been saying, and are examples of Liberal dogma that Satan has successfully forced upon the people of Europe and more recently the USA, which are in direct opposition to the Morality of God.

I am of the belief and opinion, based upon what God tells us in the Bible, that the parent has the ultimate responsibility and authority from God, to decide right from wrong as far as the upbringing of their own children.

Liberals will tell you that the parents have no such right, and that it is the government that sets the rules for child discipline.

Who in Government or its Bureaucracy?

My question to the liberals is, **"Who is it in the government that makes these decisions?"** The government is not a single individual, but a faceless bureaucracy, with no **one person** able to set the rules.

There isn't a government on the Earth that I would be willing to cede my authority over my children to.

At this time in history, all nations of the earth are controlled by immorality. Immorality is the opposite of morality. Morality is the way of God, and therefore, immorality is the way of Satan. I suggest therefore that it is Satan who gives us the decision as to how a child is to be disciplined therefore it is Satan's Lies that Liberalism is based upon.

Spanking Your Child

Liberal Dogma says that it is a crime for a parent to spank their own child. Over the decades Liberals engaged in a successful **Coup de Ta** of the American and European governments, and have passed laws that will result in a parent being arrested and the child taken away from them, if they are seen spanking their unruly child.

It has always been my belief, that an individual who defines his or her own moral rules to live by, are doing nothing short of injuring themselves and society as a whole. This has been shown to be true when you look at the disintegration of the Family Unit, and society as a whole over the last two or three generations since Liberalism's criminalization of a parent spanking their child and Liberalisms war against teaching personal responsibility in our own actions.

Obey your parents

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; that it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the Earth.

Ephesians 6:1-3

When your child does wrong, as a parent, you know right from wrong, and it is your responsibility, under God's instruction, that you reprimand your child, so that they will learn right from wrong. Knowing right from wrong is an aspect of God's Morality, but more than that it is what makes Man greater than the animals that have no such knowledge. If the child is not taught right from wrong then they will invent their own morality.

Remember: When Adam and Eve ate from the tree of the knowledge of right and wrong, they committed the first sin. Satan does not want your children to know right from wrong. When a child grows up

without an understanding of right and wrong, they will too often choose wrong, as is evidenced by how far the last several generations of Man have slipped away from God's Morality and righteous behavior.

When you have hundreds of millions of individuals with each their own definitions of what is right and what is wrong, then chaos is the result.

There are religions that we could turn to, that espouse morality. These religions can give the parents guidance as to how to discipline our children, but what a Christian considers as being moral, a Muslim would find immoral, therefore religion is just as divided on the subject of morality as is the bureaucracies of the nations. It is for this reason why we as individuals, need to study and learn the Ways of God, and make those ways our guide for our own morality as well as how we are to raise and discipline our children.

Children Need a Moral Base

How can we expect our children to grow up with a moral base unless we provide them with one that is **recognizable and unquestionable?** Children need guidance and limitations on their actions as they grow up. Those that decide for themselves more often than not choose badly. This is evidenced in the world today, by so many children that have no concept of mercy, compassion, or giving respect to others.

God Defines Discipline

*And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but nurture them in the chastening and admonition of the Lord. **Ephesians 6:4***

There is one in this world who has authority to decide right from wrong, good from evil, and that is God, therefore it is to God's Morality that all of Man must obey and all parents must use as a foundation of when and how discipline of our children is given.

The word **provoke** is defined as: to make somebody feel angry, to stir somebody to an emotion or response.

The word **nurture** is defined as: to give tender care and protection to a young child, animal, or plant, helping it to grow and develop, to encourage somebody or something to grow, develop, thrive, and be successful.

The word **chastening** is defined as: to make somebody less self-assertive and more subdued, to subject somebody to discipline.

The word **admonition** is defined as: a mild but earnest rebuke, advice for or against doing something.

All of these definitions amount to this; God has given instruction on how we as parents are to give **discipline** to our children. We are not to **provoke**, them into anger or rage by abusing them but to give **nurturing** instruction through our love for them, and **chastening** when it is necessary for the child to learn right from wrong, or when they become unruly or combative, and to **admonish** them when they are in error, so that they will learn righteousness. All this is so that they will live in reverence and obedience to the Laws of God and of the civil governments under which they live. In the following verses God gives additional instructions as to the merits of discipline.

Raise up a child as is right

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Proverbs

22:6

Take Note: God uses the word “**Train**” in the above verse. To “**Train**” someone is to educate them. God therefore is saying that the act of discipline is a form of education in the School of knowing right from wrong.

If you raise your children in the **Discipline of Righteousness**, teaching, respect, mercy, patience and kindness, then your children will grow up with these moralities taught to us by Jesus, and will have them all the days of their lives.

A Child without discipline

He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

If you ignore your children or do not teach them right from wrong, then they will grow up in the ways of Satan, “**Iniquity**.” If you then attempt to discipline them, after they have grown, it will be in vain for it will be too late.

Rod of Correction

Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

Proverbs 22:15

When you teach a child from an early age right from wrong, as God defines right and wrong, these lessons will be kept by that child all through his life.

As I have said before, a child who decides for themselves what is right and wrong will most likely choose poorly. Only by giving correct instruction and discipline when needed, will a child gain correct understanding.

Do not think that God is condoning the using of a “**Rod**” or any weapon in the disciplining of your child. The “**Rod of Correction**” is symbolic of loving discipline, not corporal punishment.

A Child left to himself

The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame. **Proverbs**

29:15

The “**Rod**” as used in this verse is symbolic of the act of discipline, not to be taken literally as in using a rod or some other weapon in disciplining you child. God does not advocate the use of violence or the inflicting of pain upon your child in your effort to discipline them. God wants that you discipline out of love for your child. How could anyone submit someone they love to pain and suffering?

God’s Morality is foundation of discipline

The Morality of God is all about, **peace, mercy, understanding, being considerate of others and having respect for others** among other moral imperatives. It is by teaching your children God’s morality, and admonishing them when they transgress away from it, that God commands us parents to discipline our children. The best teacher is someone who exercises that which they teach, thereby being an example for those they teach, to live by. As a parent, you cannot admonish your child of something, then turn around and to that which you have disciplined your child for doing.

If you are a smoker or a heavy drinker, but you tell your child that they are not to do as you do, then you are being a poor example. If you want to earn the respect of your child, ask them to assist you in ending your bad habit of smoking or over drinking. Together you will forge a true bond, and mutual respect.

The Parable of the Country Bumpkin

An undisciplined child can be likened to a country bumpkin who has been invited to have dinner at the Governors table; he will not know what fork to use or even how to sit at the table, having never been educated in the finer points of decorum. An undisciplined child will be as unsightly and boorish in society as is this country bumpkin is in polite society.

The False-Hood of Liberalism

The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame. When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increaseth: but the righteous shall see their fall. Proverbs 29:15-16

When you have one child who is misbehaving it is unsightly, but when you have a multitude of undisciplined children that then grow into misbehaving adults, then you will see lawlessness multiplied throughout society. This is the society that we live in today, because liberalism has deemed it wrong to discipline our children at an early age.

The words, “**but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame,**” relates to the shame that a mother has when a child of hers is found to be a thief or a murderer or a rapist. All of these sins are easily done by those that have no knowledge of what is right and what is wrong. As is evidenced in the world today, the mother also feels shame when her child treats her with disrespect and loathing, which is an aspect of Satan’s immoral behavior.

The last part of the above two verses tells us that “**the righteous shall see their fall,**” is a prophecy of the End of Days when all evil will be removed from the Earth. Those who adhere to the dogma of Liberalism and therefore fail to give discipline of their children, when it is called for, are the “**Wicked**” that God is referring to, as well as those of their children that are **not** brought up in the Ways of God. Those who are brought up and who live within the Morality of God will therefore see the demise of those that live immoral lives, while the Righteous shall live on in Eternal Life.

Correct Thy Son

Correct thy son and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul. Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he. Proverbs 29:17-18

A child that is given instruction as to what is right and wrong, and then is given discipline to remind the child when they do wrong, will grow into an adult that is well centered to deal with the tribulations of life, which will in turn make him happy in life.

When a child is spoiled and not educated in right and wrong, he will always go through life as if he is deserving of everything, but will be frustrated and angry when everything is not forthcoming to him.

Society an Extension of the Child

When society as a whole is without a moral base, the result will be a government without morality. Then the government, those who are elected as well as those in the bureaucracy that makes it run, will become more and more decadent and therefore unable to be trusted. This is apparent in all levels of the American Government today, with all its graft and corruption, not to mention incompetence.

It is the responsibility of a government to keep its citizens safe, not just safe from harm from outside enemies, but safe from internal enemies as well. Government corruption is as much an enemy of the people as is any gun totting terrorist. When a government is without morals, then those in the government will be without morals. That is a recipe for destruction and chaos.

Personal Freedoms Tempered

I am a firm believer in personal freedoms. I have always been a rebel, and resisted rules of conduct imposed upon me, which is one of the reasons why I rebelled against the idea of Politically Correct. At the same time however, I also realized that individual freedoms must be tempered by the needs of society as a whole. The rights of the many must over rule the rights of the few. Whenever this is not true, then chaos is the result. A society in chaos is a society destined to fail.

It has become a trend in the United States, due to Political Correctness, that the rights of the individual outweigh the rights of the many. Those rights, of those who engage in crimes, over shadow the rights of their victims, which is a direct result of the ideology of Liberalism. It is this that I see as the greatest reason for social decline in western society, and why I say that it is not Radical Islam or Russian, or China, that is the greatest threat to the world today, but Liberalism and its growing control of the governments of the world.

God Expects More

From my diligent study of the Bible, I have come to understand that God imposed a set of moral laws upon Man, the Ten Commandments and then the teachings of Jesus, so to elevate Man above the animals of the earth and thereby bring man closer to God who is a moral being.

God gave us free will to decide for ourselves to worship God or not. Those who choose to worship God as he commands will be given wonderful gifts such as eternal life and entry into Heaven. However, why would God wish to give such an enormous gift to mere animals? By imposing a set of moral laws on Man, God expects more of us than the animals, which have no such restriction imposed on their actions.

Correct Way of Parenting

As you can see in the Bible, God shows us the correct way of bringing up our children. This is a strong contrast to the way Liberalism says we should bring them up. Just look around you at the society that liberalism has created, is this as you want your child to grow into? This contrast is the same as God verses Satan, and this is why I say that Liberalism is the False Prophet and the False Prophet is the weapon used by Satan, to attempt to destroy God's Morality from the minds of Man.

Crucible of the Soul

If we are unwilling to live within the moral restrictions God has imposed on us, during our short lives here on Earth, then what could God possibly expect if he brought us up to Heaven. Our life here on Earth, is a crucible of the soul. Only those who survive the fire of living under the influence of Satan, and still live by God's Morality, shall ever have a chance of entering Heaven.

Authority of Parents

Parents: The Symbol of God

*Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. **Ephesians 6:1***

For me, Morality is more than a set of rules of conduct however. Morality is the status of individuals within the family unit. God made parents, the father and the mother, to be the symbol of him, the Father in Heaven.

Patriarch of the family of Man

*Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; that it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. **Ephesians 6:2-3***

God is the Patriarch of the family of Man. As the head of the family unit, it is the responsibility and the duty of the Parents to set the rules of conduct of their family unit. The guide that parents should use in setting these rules is the Morality of God. God is the Father in Heaven, and therefore the head of the family of Man. God's laws are imposed on us just as the rules of conduct of our parents on Earth. God has in fact given our parents this authority over the children in their household.

This latter, is the foundation for the authority of the parent to discipline their children, with **verse 6:4** above being kept in the minds of the parents. But it is also a warning to the parents. Do not abuse your authority over your children. To discipline is one thing, to beat them or otherwise abuse them, is not condoned by God.

Nurture with Love

*And, ye fathers provoke not your children to wrath: but nurture them in the chastening and admonition of the Lord. **Ephesians 6:4***

You are to nurture them with love, and teach them. Discipline should be tempered by the infraction done by the child. God is our father in Heaven. If God treats us with love and understanding, even when we sin, then so too must the parents treat their children with love and understanding when they are disobedient?

When a parent disciplines their child without a reason, where no infraction has occurred, or the discipline is greater than the infraction warrants, then the child will become resentful of the parent, and lose respect for them. In order to honor someone you need to be able to respect him or her first. God wants the parents to know, that discipline has to be tempered by love. For when you love someone, you are incapable of doing harm to him or her, or being unjust.

The Correct Point of Discipline

I have always believed that God has a sense of humor, and in his creation of Man, he provided the perfect attribute on which to discipline our children. It is known as the buttocks. When a parent strikes their open hand on the buttock of their child, both the child and the parent feels the pain. When a parent is forced to

discipline a child, it is as much the parent's short comings in teaching the child, as it is the willfulness of the child. So therefore both should be subjected to the pain.

A child should never be struck with a stick or rod or a belt, or any other form of weapon, only the open hand of the parent should be used, and only on the buttocks, for pain will be felt but no permanent damage or injury will occur. If a parent hits so hard as to cause real injury to the child then they too will have injured their own hand.

As with Sons

*If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? **Hebrews 12:7***

If you endure being disciplined by your parents, then God will deal with you as your father as well. God then asks the question, "What kind of a child will be the result that has never been disciplined by their parents?" This is to say, that all children at some time as they are growing up, need to be disciplined. That is the nature of growing up and attempting to exert one's own authority over one's self. Those that are not disciplined will grow up spoiled and disobedient not just to their parents but to the laws of their nations and to the Law of God.

To Discipline is the Way of God

This verse is another example why I believe that the Social Liberals are in extreme error, and in fact are Satan's dupes, in regards to bringing up a child. Liberalism insists that it is not right to discipline a child. Liberalism preaches that too publicly spank a child will somehow injure the child's self-esteem, or create a mental illness from the humiliation that such a discipline creates. I say, we all need a little humility from time to time, regardless of our age. This verse, **Hebrews 12:7**, tells me that a spanking, in public or in private, is condoned by God, **and therefore liberal dogma is in direct opposition to the Word of God.**

Remember: That which is opposed to God is Satan, and therefore evil.

Against the will of God

Liberal dogma has even gotten to the point that some of the governments of the world, have passed laws to punish the parents, and even remove the children from their custody, if they as much as give that child

a spanking. These kinds of laws are against the will of God. Those social liberals who promote this kind of a law are themselves in opposition to God, and therefore promoters of Satan's False Gospel.

Is Your Child a Bastard?

But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons?

Hebrews 12:8

To further hammer home this moral lesson, God gives us the above verse.

Bastard Defined

The word "**Bastard**" is defined as:

- 1- An offensive term for somebody regarded as obnoxious and disagreeable.
- 2- An offensive term for somebody born to unmarried parents.
- 3- Something that is inferior, debased, or of questionable or mixed origin.

If a child is not disciplined then what kind of a person will he/she grow up to be, God uses the word "**Bastards**" to show how he considers such a child and their parents. If the parent's love their children so little that they would not take the time and effort to discipline where discipline is called for, then why would God wish to invite either, child or parent into Heaven?

It is a commandment of God that we raise our children the knowledge of right and wrong as is shown in the following verses.

Obedience is Right

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; that it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

Ephesians 6:1-3

These above verses are a two edged sword. In them God is giving command that the children are to be obedient to their parents, but God is also telling us that if we live in righteousness, then we will live long on the Earth. If you live according to the Word and Commandments of God, and give worship to God exactly as

God commands, then you are justified in the expectation and hope of everlasting life. If you engage in disobedience not just to your parents, but also to God, then there is only eternal death that awaits you.

The second edge of this sword is that these verses are telling the parents, that it is your responsibility to raise your child up in righteousness, failure of the parent to do this is as much a sin against the commandments of God as is the child who fails to be obedient.

When a child, is left to decide what is right and wrong on their own, they will most often chose wrong. When the parent shirks their responsibility, it leaves the door open for Satan to enter in. This will lead the children to live unhappy lives of frustration, when they do not get their own way when they grow up in the real world.

A Duty and Responsibility

*Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. **Exodus 20:12***

The Fifth Commandment makes the correct upbringing of children the duty and responsibility of the parents. To discipline a child is a commandment from God that the parent should prepare the child for the trials and tribulations of life, as well as obedience to God and country. Failure in this is a sin of the parents against God, just as the wayward child commits sins when he/she makes the wrong choices in life. Failure of the parent to discipline their child when it is called for is a sin of the parents, because they are in turn allowing their child to sin against the Word of God.

To Know the Love of the Parent

If the parent has so little concern for their child, then they are treating that child as one would treat a bastard. **Hebrews 12:8** above tells me that if the parents treat the child as a bastard, then God will treat them the same, unless the child somehow finds God on their own despite their parent's short comings. To never have been disciplined, when it was called for, is to not know the love of the parent. If you never know the parents love, then how will you recognize Gods love when he gives it?

Consider this: when a child is constantly being bad, and doing things to upset their parents, the parents will so often sigh and say, **"The child just wants attention."** **Well! Yea!** If you as a parent haven't got the time to give attention to your child, then you are telling that child that you do not love them. To the child, even the attention given in a spanking, is better than no attention at all. Next time your child acts up,

don't spank him or her, simply pick them up in your arms and give them hugs and kisses, and tell them you love them. Next time, don't wait for the child to act up. A Hug a day keeps the Blues away, not to mention Satan. A parent, who fails to discipline their child, is just as bad as a parent that abuses their child in the name of discipline.

Discipline is Instruction against Evil

*Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? **Hebrews 12:9***

After having been disciplined by our parents, do we not still love them? In obeying God and accepting his disciplines, should we not still love him, he who offers us eternal life?

Partakers of God's Holiness

*For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness. **Hebrews 12:10***

Remember: the word "**Holy**" means truth, therefor to partake in the Lords Holiness is to live in God's Truth.

Our parents discipline us, so that we will obey their dictates. Our parents are extending their authority over us, for their own reasons and standards. God disciplines us so that we might know his morality, which is his righteousness, and there by enter into Heaven and thus, adorn in his glory. By embracing the six moral imperatives of God found in the Ten Commandments, as well as those taught by Jesus, then we too will make his glory our glory. The reason God has invited us to join him in Heaven is because he seeks companions, but his companions must have the same sense of Honesty, and Morality that he has.

Parable of the Mansion

*In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. **John 14:1-2***

In the above verses, Jesus us informing you and I that if we live in righteousness, that he Jesus will prepare an mansion for us in Heaven, which is the house in which God the Father resides.

I think of God's invitation of entering into heaven in the following light. You live alone in large a mansion with many rooms, so you decide you would like others around to share your home and give you companionship. So you place an ad inviting others to come live with you. In the ad you spell out the kind of people that should respond. In this way you have given a list of what you consider to be right and wrong.

A man comes knocking upon your door; he is scraggly looking, with a dirty T-shirt and alcohol on his breath and a cigarette in his mouth. In contrast, you shower and change your clothes daily, you don't drink and you don't smoke.

This person has none of the personality traits that you hold dear, and is therefore nothing like you. Of course you would reject this person from living in your home.

The same would be true of a man who is as I described the above with the dirty T-shirt; what if it were he who owned the large mansion, and wanted to have companions come live with him. What if someone like me, who does not smoke, does not drink alcohol, and does not like to "**Party Hearty**" all the days of the week, came knocking on his door. This man would no more want such as me to come live with him than I would want him to come live with me.

God's Morality

God gives us the Ten Commandments so that we will know how to be like him. God has advertised that he wants people to come live with him in heaven. The Ten Commandments tell us what kind of people that he wants just as the above Parable examples gave their lists of the sort of people they would have come live with them. The Ten Commandments include six moral imperatives, which are the minimum moral traits that we must embrace as our own moral character, if we ever want to have a chance of entering Heaven.

When we knock on God's door and ask to come live with him, we must show God that we love him and what he stands for. God Says, do not kill, if you have killed, then you need to show God that you have repented this sin and have changed who you are so that you can attest to God that you will never kill anyone again.

God tells us to repent our sins, and then ask God to forgive us for having shown our disrespect of God for having broken his laws in the first place. If you can humble yourself to the God of Creation, then you may find God's forgiveness and salvation.

Peaceable Fruit of Righteousness

*Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. **Hebrews 12:11***

It is never pleasant to be disciplined, as it is happening, we find it grievous and humiliating. However after a time, if our parents disciplined us out of their love for us, we understand the reason for it, and the lessons we learn give us peace and instruction, thus making us a better person and closer to our parents and to God, for our having endured it.

Give unto Caesar that which is Caesar's

Despite all that I have just said about liberal governments being contrary to the will of God, it is not the place of the Saints of God to involve themselves in the politics of the nation in which they abode. Jesus has assigned each of us, who are the Saints of God, a work to do, which is to continue the work that he performed while he walked on the earth. That is to teach others how to come to God, by showing them the truth that Satan has hidden from the world. This will keep us all too busy to be getting into politics. Besides, when Jesus returns, he will establish his government in the world, and will at that time inform us what he needs from us in that government. If you are involved in politics, what God wants from us may be in opposition to any political moves that we might have established, and thereby could potentially put us in opposition to God, so I strongly suggest that we as God's Saints stay out of our countries politics.

Benjamin Franklin

When religion is good, it will take care of itself. When religion is not able to take care of its self and God does not see fit to take care of it so that it has to appeal to the civil power for its support, it is evidence to my mind that the cause is a bad one.

The only reason that a Saint of God would have for getting involved with politics is to fight against the laws that Satan has caused to be enacted that are in direct opposition to the Law of God, however, the following quote may show you why I advise against getting involved.

I think of Benjamin Franklin's comments in this light. When a church has to resort to threats, violence, intimidation, torcher, and murder to force people to attend its services and live by its dogma, then that Church is not of God, for those traits are not the Way of God, they are the Way of Satan. God will call those to him to worship, that are his pleasure, and there is nothing that you or I or the civil government can do

to bring people to worship God as he commands; only God can accomplish this through the truths that he speaks.

In other words, if God is not behind the religion that it needs the civil government to enact laws to support it, then the religion is not of God, but of Satan. In that same light, it is not for a Saint of God, to take up arms, or any other of the instruments of war, to progress your religious believes, God will shine the light of his truth on those that he will, as is his pleasure, nothing we can do that God will not do himself. When Jesus returns, he will take care of all those that are in opposition to him, he will not need our help, in dispensing justice.

The “**work**” that Jesus tells us to do, is to educate those we come into contract with, of God’s True Word. To give instruction does not mean to impose our will upon others. You tell God’s Truth, either you will be heard or others will reject what you say, this is God’s will that those he chooses will see the light and those who will not see the light of God’s Truth.

Personal & Intimate Relationship

*But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou has shut thy door, pray to thy father which is in secret; and thy father which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly. **Matthew 6:6***

What this verse from Jesus is telling me is that you do not need a Church, or a Pastor, or a Congregation to give worship to God. When you go into a closet and close the door, you are left alone in the dark. When you therefore pray to God, it is only to him, on a personal and intimate path.

To be a part of a religion is unnecessary other than to have comradery with others with the same faith as you. But for the purpose of giving worship to God, a dark secluded closet is all that is needed.

As Sheep in the Midst of Wolves

*Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves. **Matthew 10:16***

We who are the Saints of God are the voice of God in the midst of the ravages of Satan’s Lies, God needs that we reveal his truth so Satan’s lies will be manifest for the lies that they are. Let your voice be the pleasant sound of a dove when it sings, not the growls of a wolf.

Honour thy Father and thy Mother

The Morality of God tells the head of the family that discipline of the child is required. Part of giving respect and honor to our Father and Mother is to accept the rules of conduct that they have set for us, regardless whether you think them fair or correct. If you as a child rebel against those rules of conduct, then why would God not think you would rebel against your father in Heaven.

A Sin of the Parents

To set rules of conduct and then **not** discipline those who break those rules, is more a sin of the parent than a sin of the child. It is the nature of a child to test his or her independence from their parents. It is therefore required of the parent to enforce his/her rules of conduct. God has said, that a child who is not disciplined for breaking the rules, must be unloved by the parent. For if the parent feels discipline to be too arduous to perform, then their love for their child is negligible. If your parent on Earth does not love you, then why should our Father in Heaven give us any notice?

A Son not Chastened

*If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? **Hebrews 12:7-9***

“If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons.” If your father on Earth disciplines you where discipline is called for, then he is showing you his love, in that he wants you to do right not wrong, as your father on Earth thus shows his love so too will your father in heaven show his love by treating you as his son. This truth can be illustrated in the following.

Brothers and Sisters of Jesus

While he yet talked to the people, behold, his mother and his brethren stood without, desiring to speak with him. Then one said unto him, “Behold, thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to speak with thee.” But he answered and said unto him that told him, “Who is my mother? And who are my brethren?” And he stretched forth his hand toward his disciples, and said, “Behold, my mother and my brethren! For

whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.”

Matthew 12:46-50

What Jesus is telling me, which goes along with what I was showing you before, is that those who obey the Word of God, which is the Law of God, will be treated by God not as subjects of God but his brethren, **“the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.”** For me this means one thing; the Saints of God are not just the people of God but the sons of God, and as such we are the inheritors of the wealth of God. Just as in human civilizations, the sons and daughters of the deceased receive the wealth of their parents upon their death, they inherit from them. So too, do the Sons of God inherit from their Father in Heaven. Not in God’s death but in his glory and in the entirety of the universe that God created.

“For what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.” God is asking you the question, if your father or mother never disciplined you, then what does that say about their love for you? Are you not their son but a bastard for whom they have no love or care for? God then goes on to ask the question, **“Are we all who are loved by our parents not also partakers of chastisement when it was called for?”** In that we are partakers, then it is correct that we as parents must give chastisement to our children when it is called for just as our parents chastised us when we were young.

“Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?” If your parents did discipline you, did you not still love them and give them your respect. If you did, then when God disciplines you, and points out your errors, it is correct that you still love him and give honor to him. The discipline that your parents give to you helps you to become a better person, but the discipline that God gives you helps to guide you to eternal life, and entry into heaven.

It is my opinion that a child left to their own devices, will more often than not, choose wrong. It is the job of the parent to assist their children to acquire the skills necessary to deal with the tribulations of life. Failure of the parent will too often result in the failure of the child.

God has given us instructions as to how we are to discipline our children, when it becomes politically incorrect to obey God’s instructions, then it is up to us to rebuke liberalism and those anti-God laws that Satan has managed to get enacted by the civil governments.

Teaching Right and Wrong

*Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? **Hebrews 12:9***

Disciplining a child is nothing less than teaching the child the difference between right and wrong. If this concept is not ingrained into the personality of the child early in life, then it is less likely to be accomplished as the child reaches their years of adolescence.

This is a personal requirement between the Parent and the child, or within the family unit, and being in compliance with the directions given by God. The last thing we need is having a civil government forcing us to discipline, or to not allow us to discipline our children in any way in which God directs us to do. The law of God supersedes any laws of Man, yet Liberalism does attempt to impose instructions on the way to discipline your child which is in opposition to the Commandments of God.

Remember: what Benjamin Franklin said, if a religion needs the Civil authority to enact laws to force compliance to that religions dogma, then the religion is not of God. Liberalism has become so integrated into the Civil Governments of the world, that it has become a government sponsored religion, and as such in direct opposition to the Morality and Law of God, not to mention to being in direct opposition to the Constitution of the United States, that prohibits the government from establishing a religion.

Evil Defined

You know, I am sure, that Satan is evil, but do you know why God considers Satan to be evil? The definition of the word “**Evil**” from the dictionary is: Someone who is wicked, sinful, or the source of sorrow or distress. God considers Satan to be evil, because he rebukes God’s laws, or Satan is in opposition to God’s laws. Therefore, if you engage in any activity that is sinful, which means to be in opposition to the Word of God, then in the eyes of God you are evil.

We all know that to kill someone is to be evil, that is because it is in violation to the Sixth Commandment, **Thou shalt not kill**, but what you might not realize, that to fail to discipline your children as is spelled out in the Fifth Commandment, is also evil. They are both of the Ten Commandments, and any one is every bit as important as any other.

You may say, “Wait a minute, the Fifth Commandment doesn’t say anything about the disciplining of children, only that the child is to give honor to their mother and father.” That is true, but as I have shown before, the Ten Commandments are an abbreviation of a more in depth discussion as given in the rest of the Gospel of God. As you can see from the above explanations, the full meaning of the Fifth Commandment is found in other books of the Bible and not just in the words of the Ten Commandments.

Do Not Abuse your Child

And, ye fathers provoked not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. **Ephesians 6:4**

There is a big difference between disciplining a child and beating them or otherwise abusing them. God tells us to discipline out of love not in anger, he says, “*How can you harm someone you love?*” If as a parent you go too far beyond that which God tells us to do, then and only then do others outside your family have authority and the right to interfere. God gives a clear definition of what constitutes abuse and spanking your child in private or in public does not constitute abuse, as God defines it from the above discussion. To learn fully about how God commands that we discipline our children go to the Books of **Ephesians and Hebrews.**

Being in Obedience to God

He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad. **Matthew 12:30**

I have always reworded the above verse to say, “Anyone who does not worship God as God instructs us to do, is not worshipping God at all, and therefore is in opposition to God.” This verse has two meanings. The literal meaning based upon the context that Jesus is speaking about goes like this:

1. During the Second Advent of Christ, the angles of God will gather up into the clouds all of those that God has given the Mark of God, (the Saints of God). Those so gathered will be with Jesus in the clouds. This is known as the Rapture. All those not gathered will remain where they are, scattered all over the face of the Earth.

The second meaning goes like this.

2. I have always reworded the above verse to say, “Anyone who does not worship God as he instructs us to do, is not worshipping God at all, and therefore is in opposition to

him.” When the civil government attempts to write laws that supersede the word of God, then those laws are in opposition to the word of God. This then makes the civil government anti-God.

When the civil government attempts to write laws that supersede the Word of God, then those laws are in opposition to the word of God. This then makes the law and the civil government that enacts the laws anti-God. Those laws enacted in Europe and the USA which allows the government to remove children from their parents is contrary to the will of God, and as such are evil laws, as defined by God.

If you are not with God, as in obedience to the Morality and Law of God, then you are scattered abroad.

The Whole Law or Nothing

*For whosoever shall keep the “Whole Law,” and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of All! For he that said, (God), “Do Not Commit Adultery,” said also, “Do Not Kill.” Now if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. **James 2:10-11***

You should know that the wording used in each of the Ten Commandments is an abbreviation of a much greater meaning as given in other books of the Bible. God abbreviates so to make it easier to remember. Only by studying other books of the Bible will you learn of the greater meaning that God wants us to understand. In this light the following two verses tell us something very important.

If you think that you keep the whole law, which includes the Ten Commandments as well as others given by Moses and Jesus, but keep the First Day of the Week (Sunday) as the Sabbath which is in direct opposition to the Word of God, then you are a transgressor of the law. With God it is all or nothing, there is no middle road. Either you Love God or you Hate God, **either you are with God or you are scattered abroad.**

With Jesus or Not with Jesus

*He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad. **Matthew 12:30***

What Jesus is telling us is that it is not enough that you call yourself a Christian, you must keep the whole law. If you only keep nine of the Ten Commandments, then you are not truly with Jesus, for he taught the whole law.

What is the Whole Law?

You must live your life in the Morality of God as shown in the last six of the Ten Commandments as well as in the Teachings of Jesus Christ, but that is not enough, the whole law also includes the first four of the Ten Commandments which give instruction and commandment on how we are to give worship to God. If you fail in any one of those instructions and commandments, then you are not truly a follower of Jesus Christ regardless of what you call yourself.

Greatest Commandment

Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying, "Master, which is the great commandment in the law?" **Matthew 22:35-36**

Remember: we are discussing Liberalism as a False Religion, and that it is Liberalism that is referred to in the Book of Revelation that I see as being the False Prophet.

In the above verse, one of the Pharisees, in an effort to discredit or cause Jesus to trip up in his knowledge of scripture, asks a reasonable question.

These verse reveals that even in the time of Jesus, Satan was attempting to present lies as a way of hiding God's True Word from the people. If Jesus had given preference to any one of the Ten Commandments over the others, someone would have been offended, and such preference could not be supported, not even by Jesus. Understanding this conundrum, Jesus gives a completely unexpected, yet just the same true response.

Love the Lord Thy God

Jesus said unto him, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment." **Matthew 22:37-38**

Even though it is not spelled out in any words in the Ten Commandments, the intent of God is that in obeying God's Commandments, we thus manifest our Love for God. God wants that we demonstrate our love for him, and therefore this that Jesus is telling us in answer to the question, is true, and is correct.

Love Thy Neighbour

*And the second is like unto it, "Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. **Matthew 22:39-40***

You see, God does not want that we only love him, but that we also love each other. We are all brothers in God, and when we live by God's Morality, and we give worship to God as God commands, then we are also brothers with Jesus.

Saints of God Defined

When Jesus was asked which of the commandments was the greatest, he did not give us anyone of the Ten Commandments in his answer, Jesus gave us what has become known as the **Two Commandments of Jesus**, which is **to love God, with all your heart, soul and mind, as well as to love each other.**

Do you understand what Jesus means by that, and even more important, do you know how to give that kind of powerful love to God? **The Ten Commandments are known as God's Law**, but God does not want that we keep only the law but also that we do so out of love, for God, and for each other. Those who have accomplished this powerful act of love are those who also are defined as the Saints of God.

It is for this reason why Jesus tells us we must love God with **all our heart and soul and mind**; a full and complete love, not just the act of keeping and obeying the Law. How do you manifest your love for God? The following is a further discussion on this subject.

Jesus' First Commandment

*But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together. Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying, Master, which is the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind." This is the first and great commandment. **Matthew 22:34-38***

Do you understand what Jesus is telling us? The Greatest of all the Commandments is not even one of the Ten Commandments, but that we **love God with all our heart, soul and mind**. I suggest that this being considered by Jesus, the greatest of all the commandments, we should take the time to understand why.

In the above Jesus is asked a question, **“which of the Ten Commandments is the greatest of them all?”** Instead of giving as an answer to the question one of the Ten Commandments, Jesus gives as an answer something that is no part of the Ten Commandments, at least not at first glance.

“This is the first and great commandment.” To top that off, Jesus tells us that this very powerful showing of love for God is the greatest of all the commandments.

This tells me, that the greatest commandment as defined by Jesus is not even one of God’s Ten Commandments, but that Jesus wants us to have this powerful showing of love for God. This forces me to wonder, what then is Jesus telling us. What does it mean, or how do we manifest such a powerful love for God. I am left with no choice but to give thought and study as to what Jesus is attempting to teach us. Do you, the reader, know what Jesus means, or how to manifest this level of love for God?

How to love God?

*Jesus said unto him, “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. **Matthew 22:37-38***

The question for me is, **“How do you love God with all your heart, soul, and mind?”** Do I just say, **“I love you Lord, God, creator of the universe, and I accept that you came to live amongst us in the flesh of a Man, the Christ Jesus, and for me you are my savior and redeemer?”** There are some that I have talked to that say yes, that is all you have to do and you are saved. They tell me, that in this I will be saved and redeemed by the Grace of Jesus and that I do not have to do anything else as a way of proofing myself or giving demonstration of my love. I have looked all through the Bible, and I cannot find where any of those words are used. If something told you by another person was never spoken by God, and you know that all that God has spoken is found in the Bible, then if you can’t find it in the Bible, who spoke it if not God?

Because I have been unable to find those words in the Bible, I consider what these people are telling me is not of God. This has convinced me that something more is required as a showing of my love? After all there are several religions, that call themselves Christian, and of course the Jewish and Muslim religions and they all claim that they are the true faith. However, there is only One God, so I have to believe that there can

be only one true faith. The true faith, the true way of worshiping God, has to be the one that God himself has told us of. With this in mind I gave prayer to God, and asked him to show me his truth.

It has been my experience, since I began my journey in search of God's Truth, that God quite often gives me answers to my prayers while I am reading the Bible. So I began a diligent study looking forward to his answer. The question still persists, "How do I manifest this powerful love," as asked for in Jesus' first Commandment? This gives me cause to define Love, as part of researching **diligently** that which I read in the Bible as told to us in the following.

Not Enough to Declare Jesus

"I love them that love me; and those that seek me early (diligently) shall find me." **Proverbs 8:17**

The above verse tells us that **God loves those who love him**. This once more concerns me as to how I am to show this same kind of love for God. Then God continues by saying that if we **seek for God (diligently) we will find him**. Do you not see that God has given definition as to how we are to show our love for him by seeking him diligently?

This tells me that I am correct in thinking that there is something that we must do, some kind of an act that we must perform as a way of manifesting our love for God. To declare Jesus as your savior is not enough, you must demonstrate your love by engaging in an exercise of your time and effort as a way of manifesting your love.

Defining Love

The American Heritage dictionary has many different definitions of the word "**Love**," but the one that seems best associated with this question is, "To have a deep, tender, ineffable feeling of affection and solicitude toward."

Wanting to be sure that I understood the definition, I looked up the definition for the word **ineffable**, which is, "Incapable of being expressed; indescribable or unutterable." I also decided to look up the word **solicitude**, just to be certain I understood its meaning, the Dictionary tells us **solicitude** is "A cause of anxiety or concern."

With this information, a more complete definition of the word LOVE arises, “To have a deep tender, indescribable, and unutterable feelings of affection and anxiety or concern toward another.”

I ask you, the reader, does that definition help you to understand how to manifest your love for God? It doesn't help me all that much. I suggest we look for the meaning of Love, in a biblical perspective. After all, God and Jesus both tell us to love them, so doesn't it stand to reason that they have told us how to manifest this love?

With all thy Heart

*Jesus said unto him, “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. **Matthew 22:37-38***

This is the first part of how to show your love for God. Have you ever given thought as to what it means to love with all your heart? For me it goes as follows: I love my wife of 47 years with all my heart, but how do I manifest this love for her?

The words “I Love You.” are just hollow words until you fill them with substantive acts. You can tell one hundred people you love them, but until you demonstrate that love in some fashion or other, the words remain hollow. I show my love for my wife every time I caress her hair or kiss her on the neck or just come up to her and give her a hug.

This is how you fill the hollow words with actions. The question arises, “how do you translate this kind of action to God?” You can neither see nor feel God, therefore none of these actions manifest your heart felt love for God. This then remains a mystery for me.

With all thy Soul

*Jesus said unto him, “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. **Matthew 22:37-38***

This is the second part of how Jesus teaches us to love God. Have you ever loved anyone with all your soul, do you even truly know what a soul is? The Bible tells us that God made Man a living soul, not that he gave us a living soul but that he made us a living soul.

A Living Soul

*And the Lord God formed Man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and Man became a living soul. **Genesis 2:7***

As you can see, God did not give Man a living soul but in fact made Man a living soul. This tells me that a soul is part of the body and not separate from it. I have, until finding this understanding, assumed that the soul is that which got resurrected and not the body, this tells me I was wrong about that, and it is the body that gets resurrected, in that the soul is part of the body. This then causes me to ask the question once more, what is the soul?

Comparing the Dog to Man

In order to understand this I suggest that we compare Man to the other animals established on the Earth during the sixth day of creation when Man was first established. What is different from Man and those other animals that would give perspective as to what a soul is?

The Encarta dictionary defines the “Soul” as: a nonphysical aspect of a person, the complex of human attributes that manifests as consciousness, thought, feeling, and will, regarded as distinct from the physical body. This definition tells us a lot, but does not really tell me anything that I find useful in manifesting my love for God.

What my study of the Bible tells me is that there is no other animal that walks upon the land of this Earth that God has also given a soul to. Therefore we only need compare the animals to ourselves to determine what a soul might be.

In that God tells us to love him, I have to believe that the capacity to love is an indicator as to having a soul. I could use as comparison Man’s closest link to the animal kingdom and compare the apes and chimpanzees with Man’s ability to love, but I have no personal knowledge concerning this so instead I will compare Man to the only other animal that I am convinced has the capacity to show and feel love.

The dog has always been given the title as Man’s best friend. In ancient times this was because of the partnership between Man and dog in the hunt for food. In these times when we need only go to the market to acquire food, this relationship has no meaning, however the Dog is still considered Man’s best friend, because of his companionship to us, and the dogs ability to give such powerful loyalty to their masters. It is this loyalty that I have always associated with a form of love. So I am convinced that the Dog has the potential of

feeling love, yet do they in truth feel love? Many other animals show similar capabilities; therefore I wonder if the ability to feel love is indeed an aspect of what a soul is after all.

Cognitive Thought

One aspect of Man that I am convinced is not something that any other animal can do is to give cognitive thought as to what it means to love. Though the dog may have the ability to show love, it has no understanding of love or even that it does love, it is merely acting upon instinct. This is not how Man feels love; at least, this is not how I exhibit love.

Morality

But if thou wilt enter into life, KEEP the COMMANDMENTS. Matthew 19:17

In the teachings of Jesus, as well as the last six of God's Ten Commandments, God-Jesus teaches us an aspect of love, and that is morality. As part of this lesson Jesus told us the above.

Take Note: Jesus is not saying, "Keep MY Commandments," but to "Keep THE Commandments." I have oft times been told that because Jesus says to "Keep my Commandments," that he is referring only to Jesus' Two Commandments, and not to the Ten Commandments. I have always refuted that interpretation, the why of which you will see soon, but as you can see, Jesus is not saying "MY," but "THE." Yet another proof in my mind that Jesus is speaking of the Ten Commandments.

A Christian in Deeds

To call yourself a Christian, you must be of Christ; to be of Christ is to embrace the Teachings of Christ. In that Jesus teaches concerning the keeping of the Ten Commandments, then to be of Christ requires that you keep the Ten Commandments.

Eternal Life

But if thou wilt enter into life, KEEP the COMMANDMENTS. Matthew 19:17

The "LIFE" that Jesus is referring to is not our mortal life on earth but the eternal life that God offers as a gift for those who show their love for him. Jesus then listed five of the Ten Commandments, which I see as his reinforcement that it is the Ten Commandments to which he is referring. Then after giving a list of some of the Ten Commandments, Jesus once again repeated his second commandment.

Thou shalt do no murder,

Thou shalt not commit adultery,

Thou shalt not steal,

*Thou shalt not bear false witness, **Matthew 19:18***

Honour thy father and thy mother: and,

*Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. **Matthew 19:19***

When you combine this listing of the Ten Commandments with something that God repeats throughout the Bible, you will understand how God gives us definition as to how we are to manifest our love for him.

*And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. **Exodus 20:6***

It is in this verse where aspects of the soul are revealed. You see, God is telling us that if we keep his Ten Commandments, then we are showing our love for him. In this God is showing us his capacity of having mercy upon those who keep his commandments, and it is this revealing of his soul that he intends that we love with all our soul.

In the Image of God

The word “**Mercy**” is defined by the English dictionary as, one who has compassion, Pity, forgiveness, humanity, and generosity towards others. What other animal has in them the ability to exhibit any of these attributes but Man. You have been told; no doubt, from your youth that God made us in his own image; but do you know what that means?

An image need not only be a shape or a form but attributes can be an image as well. In that we, like God, have the ability to give Compassion, Pity, Forgiveness, and Generosity to others, reveals our soul, just as it does God’s soul. When you also take a look at the six moral imperatives listed in the Ten Commandments, as well as those moral imperatives taught by Jesus, you will see in them aspects of having a soul that the animals do not have. It is these that define what a soul is, and it is the soul that makes us in the image of God.

With all thy Mind

*Jesus said unto him, “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. **Matthew 22:37-38***

The Third part of how Jesus tells us to love God is with our entire mind. The mind is another of the aspects of a man that none of the other animals possess. The brain of Man has the capacity to store enormous amounts of data, and then by comparing this data, using cognitive thought, to ascertain meaning and then how to apply that meaning. It is one thing to store data in memory, an ability that I see in other animals, but it is quite another to take that data and know how to make use of it. This is the difference between someone who is educated, and someone who has wisdom.

A computer can store tremendous amounts of data, depending upon the size of its hard drive, but does a computer have wisdom? Only those who access the data and use that data after consideration of the information stored within the data, have wisdom. This is true of Man, many of the human race have been educated with all kinds of knowledge, but it is only those that know how to take that knowledge and make use of it in their daily lives that have wisdom. So many, have knowledge but fail to use that knowledge, and therefore are nothing more than educated idiots, in my opinion.

Loving God with our entire mind is another way of saying that God wants us to love him from our knowledge of him and not by Blind Faith. The more you know about God and the more knowledge of God's True Word which is the everlasting gospel of God, the more you will understand what God is all about or who he is. It is my opinion, the more you understand and can discern God's truth from Satan's lies, the more you will come to love God. Perhaps now you will understand what Jesus is saying when he tells us to love God with all our heart, soul and mind.

Quoting from Deuteronomy

*But if from thence thou shalt seek the Lord thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the Lord thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice: For the Lord thy God is a merciful God; he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them. **Deuteronomy 4:29-31***

One more thing, concerning this, I wonder if you are aware of. Do you know that this phrase, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind," does not originate with Jesus, but that Jesus is in fact paraphrasing from words written in the Book of Deuteronomy by the hand of Moses, some 1500 years earlier? When Jesus is giving quote from Deuteronomy he is pointing to the context of those verses in Deuteronomy, to illustrate what he is teaching us.

To love God with all your heart, soul and mind is to keep the Ten Commandments, which is what Moses is talking about in Deuteronomy.

What God requires of thee

*And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, **To keep the commandments of the Lord**, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?*

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

And now, Israel: I have given explanation of what Israel stands for in other discussions. As used in these verses, it is not referring to the Nation of Israel, but those who have overcome their sins and who keep the Commandments of God or as I have explained, God is directing this verse at those who can be defined as Israelites, or the Sons of Israel and the Saints of God.

If you seek

*But if from thence thou shalt seek the Lord thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. **Deuteronomy 4:29***

The phrase, **“thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul,”** tells me that God requires more from us than to just declare Jesus as your savior. Even the act of seeking him diligently is insufficient, as in study and research, but that we must look for God with the full desire of finding his truth and with the intent of giving worship to him when we do find him.

If you study the Bible for the purpose of understanding God’s truth, you may find his truth, but unless your search is not just for the truth but to find God himself, you will not find him, except as a result of understanding his truth. This is the difference of seeking God’s truth as an intellectual pursuit or seeking God’s truth on a spiritual pursuit.

Touched by God

I am not sure I am getting across what I intend, so let me give you a perspective in my personal search for God’s Truth. My Cousin is an ordained minister, and he would oft time quote from the Bible, and then give definition of what the quote meant. I was not versed in the Bible, yet I knew that his definitions were not always correct. I attempted to explain what the verses in fact said, but without the education in scripture that my Cousin has, he would smile at me as a wise old man would towards a young child. This frustration in my

lack of knowledge led me to study and search for the true meaning of Bible scripture. You see, I didn't begin with the desire to find God, only to find truth that would show my Cousin his error. After several months I found God as well as his truth, and my life has not been the same since.

Knowledge not Wisdom

As I was studying scripture I obtained knowledge, but I still lacked understanding. If you don't have understanding then you can't have wisdom. Frustrated, I began to look to God for instruction and direction in my study. When I finally took the time of compiling my Fifty plus years of sins and realized that I was indeed a sinner, I turned to God in prayer and asked for his forgiveness.

Touched by the Holy Ghost

Not long after that God answered my prayer in a very powerful way. In a flood of understanding, all that I had studied at that point came to me. God had touched me. It was **physical, mental, and spiritual**. Had I not been sitting down I am sure that I would have fallen down. I now know not only God's truth, but that God is real, alive, and that he created all that is, including me. I know this not from faith but from obtained knowledge. With this knowledge, I have dedicated the rest of my life to the service of God, in whatever way that he God gives me direction. So now you have a greater knowledge of what **Deuteronomy 10:12-13** is talking about as revealed from a personal account of mine.

In Tribulation

When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the Lord thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice: For the Lord thy God is a merciful God; he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

Deuteronomy 4:30-31

The phrase, "**When thou art in tribulation,**" refers to any time of sorrow or hard times, if you look to God, he will be there to give you comfort and guidance. More specifically however, it is a reference to the time of tribulation that the Jews endured during their captivity in Babylon, as well as to the Tribulation that the Saints of God endured during the 1260 years known as the Dark Ages, and then again in the Great Tribulation to take place in the End of Days that the whole Earth will have to endure.

In Latter Days

The phrase, “even in the latter days,” is a reference to the End of Days, which begin when the prophecies of Jesus that relate to the Great War, from the Book of Matthew, begin to come to pass, which is to say, that even if you have not been of God before the tribulation of the End of Days, it is still not too late for you to repent your sins and ask God for forgiveness. I was 55 + when I found God, and I am confident that he has forgiven me my life of sin, so if he can forgive me, the evil person that I was, he can forgive anyone.

Obedient to his voice

The phrase, “shalt be obedient unto his voice,” is instructing us that we must obey the laws and the Word of God, which include the Ten Commandments. It also means that what God speaks, which is his Holy Gospel and his Holy Gospel is the truth. If we accept his word as truth, and therefore realize that if God did not speak it, it is a lie then we will be obedient unto his voice.

Shortly after finding God, he revealed to me what I call God’s Truism. This truism helps me to see Satan’s lies with ease. Perhaps it will be of help you as well. True I have provided this already in this Bible Study, but it is important so I give it to you again. It goes like this:

What God Requires of you

And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

The phrase, “*what doth the Lord thy God require of thee*,” which is the original question I asked, what more must I do to be redeemed than to simply say that Jesus is my Savior?

The answer to this question is, “but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, to keep the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?”

To Fear God

“To fear the Lord thy God,” has more to do with fearing yourself, than to be in fear of God. If you are obedient to the Commandments of God, then you have nothing to fear from God, but if you are lax in your

obedience and your worship, then you do have something to fear. But it is you and your actions that will bring about God's wrath upon you, so it is yourself you should fear that you do not slip from the path of righteousness. When you understand the meaning to all ten of God's Commandments, as well as the teachings of Jesus, and live your life in obedience to those meanings, then you will be one with God and will have nothing to fear from him.

God Fearing Defined

What doth the Lord thy God require of thee? God is asking a question of the Israelites, but it is really a question that they should be asking of God. If you are an Israelite, or as that name has been expanded, a Saint of God, you should already know the answer to this question. For those of you who do not know the answer, God tells you.

But to fear the Lord thy God: The word fear is defined as: the respect and/or awe for somebody or something. The word respect is the truly important word that you should keep in mind were God is concerned. The word respect is defined as: A feeling or attitude of admiration and deference toward somebody, consideration or thoughtfulness.

The word deference is defined as: polite respect, especially putting another person's interest first, submission to the judgment, opinion, or wishes of another person, courtesy.

Let me then rephrase, **But to fear the Lord thy God:** To give respect to the Lord thy God, to have consideration and thoughtfulness to the Word of God, to put the Word of God ahead of all else, by accepting that the Word of God is truth, and thereby submit to the judgment, opinion, and wishes of God Almighty, as your Creator and Father in Heaven.

The Way of God

*And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, **to walk in all his ways,** and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good? **Deuteronomy***

10:12-13

To walk in all his ways, and to love him: The **“Ways of God”** is a reference to the morality of God. What God is telling us is for you and I who love God, to manifest our love for him by embracing the morality of God, and making God’s morality our morality, no longer laws written on tables of stone, but personality traits written upon our heart. It is in this way that a Saint of God is **above the law**, because they are no longer laws to be obeyed but aspects of our own moral character and therefore making us **“One With God.”**

The phrase, **“to walk in all his ways,”** is another way of saying, to keep his commandments, as well as the teachings of Jesus, for these moral imperatives are the ways of God, and **are a reflection of his personality, moral character, and his honor**, which is to say that God wants that we be like him, in our personality, moral character and in his high ideals of honor.

The phrase, **“To serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, to keep the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes,”** tells me that God requires more from us than to just declare Jesus as your savior. Even the act **of seeking him diligently** is insufficient, as in study and research, but that we must look for God with the full desire of finding his truth and with the intent of giving worship to him when we do find him.

If you study the Bible for the purpose of understanding God’s truth, you may find his truth, but unless your search is not just for the truth but to find God himself, you will not find him. This is the difference of seeking God’s truth as an intellectual pursuit or seeking God’s truth on a spiritual pursuit.

Pointing to the Ten Commandments

*And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, **To keep the commandments of the Lord,** and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?*

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

In the above phrase, God is telling us that we are to show our love for him **with all thy heart and with all thy soul**, and then defines how we are to manifest this powerful kind of love, **by keeping the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes**. It is in this that Jesus is including as context as to what Jesus means when he tells us **to love God with all our heart, soul and mind**. Jesus is telling us that this powerful love is manifest when we keep the Commandments of God.

Know this: the Ten Commandments are an abbreviation of the entire Holy Gospel, in those ten are the entirety of God's Word, and to keep the Ten you must also give **respect** to the entire Holy Gospel.

Jesus Quoted from Moses

When Jesus gave us his two commandments, he was quoting from the above verses in the Book of Deuteronomy. Therefore Jesus' First Commandment is not his at all but was written by Moses, at the behest of God of course, so I guess you could say that they are the words of God, but given to Moses to write down 1500 plus years before Jesus first spoke them.

If you read the verses leading up to and after these, both in Deuteronomy chapter 4 and chapter 10, you will find the context as to what Moses was talking about which gave rise to his writing these words.

To do them is to Live

Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do them, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the Lord God of your fathers giveth you.

Deuteronomy 4:1

Moses is speaking of teaching the people of Israel, **the statutes and unto the judgments,** which are the laws of Moses written by his hand, but also in this context represents all the laws of God including the Ten Commandments. This will become evident as you continue to read in Chapter 4 of the Book of Deuteronomy.

If you keep and obey the Commandments of God and live by God's Morality, and give worship to God as God has commanded that we must, then you will be given, as your reward, eternal life. Fall short of this and your reward will be eternal death.

Exactly as God Commands

*Ye shall **not add** unto the word which I command you, **neither shall ye diminish aught from it,** that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you. **Deuteronomy 4:2***

In my estimation, this verse is extremely important to anyone who truly wishes to worship God as he commands that we worship him. It is my firm understanding that if you do not worship God as he commands then you do not worship the God of Creation at all but an invention of your own.

This is something I have been saying all along, though I say it using different words. “You must worship God as he commands neither adding to nor subtracting from how he commands that we must worship him, to worship in any other manner is to not worship the God of creation but some other invention of your own.” **Do not put words into the mouth of God.**

Teach thy Sons

Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but teach them thy son, and thy sons' sons;

Deuteronomy 4:9

In these verses, Moses warns the Israelites to keep the laws of God. In that the God of Israel is the same God that is the Christ, who came to Earth in the flesh of a man, Jesus, this then tells me that this warning applies to we who follow the teaching of Jesus, just as much as it applied to them in the days of Moses. In that Jesus himself is pointing to this that was written by Moses, and the context of what Moses was talking about, is therefore the context that Jesus is pointing to, and that context is to keep the Ten Commandments and in doing this you manifest your love of all your heart, soul, and mind for God.

Moses gives warning, **“take heed to thyself,”** means to remember all those things that God has shown you, and keep the laws that God has given you. Even though you and I did not see God part the Red Sea, we know it happened and we can see it from the words written in the Bible. Therefore, when Moses tells the Israelites to remember those things that they saw, God is also telling us to remember them as well.

Satan's Deception

God wants that we and all who come after us to remember his Law and his promises, but Satan over the centuries has endeavored to cause Man to forget the Word of God by telling lies and giving false interpretations to that which God spoke.

With the fall of the anti-Christ and its ability to persecute the Saints of God, Satan has over the last several decades established the false religion of Liberalism, which carries on Satan's attempt to hide God's True Word.

The Whole Law

*For whosoever shall keep the Whole Law, **and yet offend in one point**, he is guilty of All! For he that said, (God), “Do NOT Commit Adultery,” said also, “Do NOT Kill.” Now if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the Law. **James 2:10-11***

You should understand that God-Jesus is saying that we must keep the whole law that God has given us. If you only keep some of God’s Commandments, then how can you think that you give True and Correct worship to the God of Creation. Satan, by way of his anti-Christ has hidden the truth by telling us that the Lords Day of Rest is the first day (Sunday) of the week. If you keep all the other nine of the Ten Commandments, but fail to keep the Fourth Commandment as God has spoken it, then you are guilty of “**All the commandments**.” You either love God completely, or you hate God, there is no middle road, no gray areas, only Love and Hate, Good and Evil.

Hiding meaning in plain site

*But, **the Seventh Day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God**: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates. **Exodus 20:10***

The same holds true for those who do not keep the Sabbath holy as is commanded by God. Satan has hidden the true words of God and has given another interpretation that effectively turns what God said into a lie.

God tells us: The Seventh Day, (Saturday), is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God, not the first day, (Sunday). As you can see in the above verse, this has been spoken by God himself. Either you believe and obey that which God has spoken or you do not. If you accept something never spoken by God as being the truth, then you are deceived and as such you will be given by Jesus, the Mark of the Beast, not the Mark of God.

God's Truism

If God spoke it, then you will find it in the Holy Gospel,

If God spoke it, then it is the truth,

It is the truth because it is of God,

It is of God, because God spoke it.
If God did not speak it, then you will not find it in the Holy Gospel,
If God did not speak it, then it is a lie,
It is a lie, because it is not of God,
It is not of God, because God did not speak it.

If you are a true follower of Christ, then you must believe and know that the flesh and blood man, Jesus, is Christ, and to be Christ is to be the essence of God, therefore, Jesus is God in the flesh of a man. As such, what Jesus speaks is as if God speaks.

Jesus's First and Second Commandments are therefore, commandments of God. When Satan attempts to hide the truth of Jesus's Words from you and me, then it is important that we keep God's Truism in mind, so as to help weed out the lie from the truth.

Liberalism's Attack on Morality

Condoms in School

Liberal Dogma wants us to believe that sex outside of marriage is perfectly normal and that there is no sin to engage in sex outside of marriage. To facilitate this dogma, the liberals have over the years infiltrated the governments and bureaucracies causing laws and policies to be enacted, such as the government sponsored and government paid for distribution of condoms to our children in our public schools. Liberals will tell you it is for the purpose of preventing unwanted pregnancies and venereal diseases.

Just think about it however. Liberalism does not tell our children that it is wrong or a sin to engage in Fornication, but instead tells the children that when they do engage in sex, they need to protect themselves. What does it tell our children about the morality of sexual purity if our government hands out condoms to them? It tells them that it is alright to engage in extra-marital sex. When the policies of the False Prophet takes away the shame or sin factors in having sex, then of course the children will engage in it and thereby engage in sinful acts in disobedience to the Seventh Commandment of God.

Reliance upon God's Morality

Sexual purity is an aspect of the Ways of God, (Morality of God), so when our children are encouraged to engage in sexual activities, then they are being encouraged to be in disobedience to the Word of God, which of course is a sin.

When a civil government enacts laws or policies that promote anti-God behavior, then that government is no longer worthy to rule over the people of God. The laws of Man must always be subordinate to the Law of God.

This is shown to be true and a part of the mind set of those who were involved in the establishment of the United State of America, and in the establishment of the Constitution of the United States of America.

The following is taken from the American Declaration of Independence which shows clearly that the founding fathers put their reliance on God and his morality when establishing both the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States of America.

Nature's God

To assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which **the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them.**

The Laws of Nature relate to all activities of the Earth, including the movement of the atmosphere, the growth and expansion of plants, the growth and expansion of animals, and of the growth and expansion of Man. Included in the Laws of Nature, are those aspects of all living organisms that relate to **procreation of the species.** With plants and animals, **Natures God**, placed no encumbrances or rules of conduct, but with Man, God gave us a listing of his morality, (the Ten Commandments), by which all of Man is required to live by.

As this quote from the Declaration of Independence shows, the American Founding Fathers, looked to God as their inspiration and to his morality in the formation of the New Nation and the Law upon which the nation is founded. From its onset, Liberalism has been waging war against the Constitution of the United States of America and that in turn puts Liberalism at war with the Morality of God.

Endowed By Their Creator

We hold these truths to be self-evident, **that all men are created equal**, that they are **endowed by their Creator** with certain unalienable rights that among these are **Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness**.

Life:

As used in the above quote from the American Declaration of Independence, **Life**, *relates to the God given right to live in the way and station of one's own choosing, and not being subjected to control or constraint placed upon us by a government or any of its agencies.*

Liberty:

As used in the above quote, **Liberty**, relates to **the freedom to think and act without being constrained by necessity or force, as well as the political, social, and economic right that belongs to the citizens of a state or to all people, save for those restrictions placed upon us by the Morality of God.**

With a firm reliance on Divine Providence

You see, the Founding Fathers put their reliance on God to pass judgment upon their actions and their intentions. Such was their foundation in the Love of God and of God's Morality. The Constitution, though having no such testaments directed at God, was written by the same people, for the most part, who were involved in the wording of the Declaration of Independence, and as such it is logical and required that those Laws and the Government established by the Constitution has at its foundation the Morality of God. Therefore, when the government or its agencies promote immoral behavior, that government is no longer operating within the constraints put upon it by the Constitution or by the Morality of God, and is therefore operating outside of its legal contract with the people.

Abortion

When the Supreme Court of the United States ruled that abortions were permitted under the Constitution, it did so without taking into consideration the Morality of God, and as such its ruling is anti-Christ, as is the murder of unborn children.

God's Morality

Seventh Commandment

Thou shalt not commit adultery. **Exodus 20:14**

The King James Bible says; this is the principle of sexual purity. Related to this principle are the prohibitions of incest, seduction, prostitution, fornication, etc.

Adultery Defined

The American Heritage Dictionary defines "Adultery" as, "a voluntary sexual intercourse between a married person and a partner other than the lawful spouse." If you are married and you have sex with someone other than the one you are married to, then you commit adultery. If you are unmarried and have sex with someone who is married, then you commit adultery.

You might notice, that no gender is mentioned. The words, "A Married Person," are used, so if a man is married and has a sexual relation with any other, than his lawful wife, then he has committed Adultery. If a women who is married has a sexual relation with any other than her lawful husband, then she has committed Adultery. It should also be mentioned that those with whom you have sex are also committing adultery even if they do not know that you are married.

Becoming Satan

If you lie as to your marital status so as to encourage a sexual encounter with another person, then you are engaging in the same kinds of deceptions and lies that Satan uses. You are turning yourself into Satan.

Remember: Satan is not an individual; Lucifer is an individual, Satan is a state of being. Satan is the fallen foe. If you do as is the way of Satan, then you have fallen, and as such make yourself into a foe of what God stands for. You like Lucifer, have made yourself to be Satan.

Jesus and Adultery

Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, "Thou shalt not commit adultery:" But I say unto you, that whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart. **Matthew 5:27-28**

Now I'm assuming that the converse is true as well. Any married woman who looks upon another man with lust, also commits Adultery in her heart. I also have to assume, that Christ is referring to a Married individual, lusting for another, for that follows through with the definition of adultery. What this means is if you are married and have fantasies of having sex with someone other than your spouse, those fantasies constitute adultery even if they never progress to the actual act of having sex.

In this verse Jesus is teaching the Ten Commandments, and not just teaching them but expanding on their meaning. If Jesus is teaching The Ten Commandments, then doesn't it stand to reason that to be a Christian you must keep the Commandments of God, which include the Seventh Day Sabbath?

Fornication Defined

The Encarta dictionary defines **"Fornication"** as: sexual intercourse between two consenting adults who are not married to each other. This definition could be construed as only applying to adults and that if you are a teenager, it would not apply. It is therefore necessary that we know how God defines fornication.

God defines **"Fornication"** as: "sexual intercourse between a man and woman who are not married, or any form of sexual behavior considered to be immoral." With this definition, even teenagers can be spoken of as being men and women; therefore the sinfulness of fornication for the young is every bit a sin as it is with adults.

Based upon these definitions my understanding of Adultery and/or Fornication is this, when a married person engages in any kind of sexual encounter with anyone other than their spouse, they have committed Adultery. To put it another way, **"all sex outside of the holy bonds of marriage is immoral, sinful and an abomination unto the eyes of God."**

A Beautiful Thing

Sex is a wedding gift given, by God, to husband and wife to give enhancement to the love that they already feel for each other. Think of it this way, no other animal takes pleasure out of sex. For the animals it serves only one purpose, the procreation of the species, Man on the other hand also feels love for their mates. By combining the love you feel for your spouse with the pleasure of the sexual act, you get a complete and fulfilling emotional and physical experience. This can only be achieved between two people when they have

love for each other. When you engage in a sexual encounter with any other you defile that which is beautiful and make it obscene.

Unmarried Persons

How does all this relate to non-married persons, and their sexual behavior? If Adultery is a sexual act between a married person and someone else, other than their lawfully married spouse, then how does that translate for the youth, two people that are unmarried?

The American Heritage Dictionary defines **“Fornication”** as: **“Sexual intercourse, between partners, who are not married to each other.”**

If this definition sounds a lot like Adultery, that’s because it is, and for the purpose of making it clear to the youth, and other unmarried persons, that they too are subject to this Commandment.

So let’s make this clear:

1: If a married person “Mary” has sex with someone other than their spouse, “Mike”, they both commit adultery, but the spouse, “Jim” is without sin.

2: If an unmarried person “Mike” has sex with a married person, “Mary” then they both commit adultery and have therefore both sinned.

3: If two unmarried persons “Mike and Sue” have sex with one another, then they both commit fornication, which is in essence the same as adultery and is a sin.

This then tells us that as far as God is concerned, “All sex outside of marriage is a sin.”

A Higher Purpose

Though, Man is an animal of nature, and only achieved ascension over the other beasts of the world when God made Man a living soul, thus creating Man-Kind, we still have the animal instincts of the dumb beasts. God however, has placed us to a higher purpose in this world. To conduct ourselves in sexual relations, as the beasts do, lowers us back to that state, and therefore makes us unworthy to enter into the presence and grace of God.

A Man and his Wife

In short, God condones sex only between a Husband and his lawfully married wife, all other sexual activity is forbidden by God. Therefore if you engage in sex as a top off of a night out with someone, (a date), then you are committing a sin and **Satan Loves You**.

Not a Toy

Sex is not a toy that you take out and play with, it is meant by God to be a fulfillment of the love you feel for your spouse, and all other acts of sex are obscene in the eyes of God.

A Child out of Wedlock

*A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the Lord; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the Lord. **Deuteronomy 23:2***

If a child should come about because of your Adulterous activities, then that child, “a Bastard” is unable to be a part of the Congregation of the Lord.

The American Heritage Dictionary defines “Bastard” as: “Resembling a known kind or species but not truly such.” So this child, who you would think is innocent of any sin, is because of your actions, denied the companionship of the Congregation of the Lord, in other words, entry into the Church of Christ, not just that one child but to the tenth generation, beyond that child. Only through congregation with others and with God can an individual have pure knowledge of Gods will, not to mention oneness with the community in which he lives.

By Church and Congregation, I do not mean “Organized Religion”. In an Organized Religion, the interpretation of the words of God, are dictated by a few who are in control, and any interpretations contrary to theirs are not tolerated.

My meaning of “in Congregation and Church” is others who are of your faith, and belief that Jesus’ promise of the resurrection is true, who get together to discuss and study the words of God with you.

Without the opportunity of communion with others, then that child and its offspring are hindered in their worship of God. If you worship God in any way other than that which he has dictated, then you do not

worship him at all. Therefore, that child is less likely to enter Heaven, than a child born in wedlock, all because of your sins.

You may all wonder why God would make life so difficult for an innocent child, and even those yet to be born. It seems like such an unjust punishment for those who themselves have not sinned. My sympathies are with that thought. However, it is not the child to whom this Commandment is directed. It is to those who would fornicate or commit adultery.

This is one of the things that Jesus fulfilled or should I say rendered obsolete; **Deuteronomy 23:2**, no longer does the child pay for the sins of his/her parents. This is why the Sin of Adam is no longer on our heads. It is that sin which has been forgiven through Christ, any sins you commit in your life can only be forgiven if you repent them and ask God to forgive you, which is another good reason why you need to keep the Ten Commandments. If you do not know these commandments, then how are you going to know if you are committing a sin or not?

Moral Restraint

God wants to impress upon all of us, that our actions have consequences beyond ourselves. Even if we are unable to control our own animalistic urges, the thought of the pain that we would impose upon any child that is the result of our sins, might give us pause, with the intent to persuade us away from that sin.

By having the civil governments pass out condoms, you in effect supplant this moral restraint, and in doing so the civil government puts itself into opposition to the word of God. It is in this way that the False Prophet through its false religion we call Liberalism, makes war upon the Morality of God.

Homo Sexuality

*If a man also lies with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination; they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them. **Leviticus 20:13***

You might have noticed that I used the words, “Any Other” in my above explanation, this is to point out, that a married individual, who has a sexual relation with someone of their same gender, constitutes Adultery or Fornication, as well.

In this age that I live, Homo Sexuality is not considered abnormal by society as a whole. So in that regard, the law of this Commandment would apply as well. Because God has defined marriage as being

between a man and a woman, there can be no marriage, in the eyes of God, between two of the same gender. Which is to say, that if the Civil government defines marriage to allow for Gays to be considered married, then that civil law is in direct opposition to the word of God, and is therefore of Satan, the fallen foe and enemy of God, and is yet another way that the False Prophet makes war on the Morality of God. In that such laws have in fact been passed by liberal government's shows once more how Liberalism is another name for Satan or more specifically Satan's False Gospel and the tool used by the False Prophet to extend its war against God's Morality.

God and Homo Sexuality

*If a man also lies with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination; they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them. **Leviticus 20:13***

As you can see, God speaks plainly in his condemnation of Homo Sexuality. I do not see God as giving condemnation to Homo Sexuality so much that God is giving condemnation of all sex outside the bonds of marriage between a Husband and a Wife, as God further defines as a Man and a Woman.

The whole purpose of being a Homo Sexual is to engage in sex, it has no other meaning. That God finds it an abomination is because of that as well as the fact that male with male and female with female is in direct contradiction to the natural order of the Earth as God established the Natural Order to be.

Rooted out and destroyed

It is clear to me, because God tells us that both involved are to be put to death that God wants that Homo Sexuality should be rooted out and destroyed, so that the sin and the disease will not infect the rest of society.

I once read, several years ago, that some scientist had determined that there is a difference in the chromosomes of those men who are Homo Sexual, and those that are not Homo Sexual. The Scientist then concluded that is why some men prefer other men to women. What this scientist is suggesting is that being Gay is a biological imperative.

God made male and female, for the purpose of the procreation of the species of all the animals in nature. There can be no procreation between two males or two females; therefore it is contrary to God's Natural Order.

A Choice not Biology

I think that this scientist may have been a Homo Sexual himself, and was just trying to give credence to his sexual preferences. Homo Sexuality is not a biological imperative, but a matter of choice, in other words, you choose to prefer others of your same gender, and in making this choice you chose your definition of morality over that of God.

It doesn't matter that the civil government enacts laws that agree with you or not, God's Law is the ultimate authority in this universe, therefore you still commit a sin, and you are still an abomination unto the eyes of the Lord.

The "Me, Me, Me," Factor

There is one aspect of every Homo Sexual, that I have come in contact with, that does make them different than most other men. That is their self-centered desire for personal pleasure and fulfillment, without concern for the consequence of how their actions, might affect others, or society as a whole. I call this the **Me, Me, Me attitude**. They are the center of their own world, and they have little or no concern for those around them.

Gay Marriage

All sex is an abomination unto the eyes of God except that between a Husband and Wife, and that is further defined by God as a Man and a Woman. All other marriages, promoted by Liberalism, which is the religion of the False Prophet, even if legal under civil law, are sins under God's definition of what constitutes a married couple.

God's law is supreme over the laws of Man, and any civil law that violates God's law is in opposition to God and therefore is itself a sin. All civil laws enacted by all governments of Man that violate the Morality of God are aspects of the False Prophet working to destroy God's Morality.

Not only are these laws in opposition to the Word of God, but so too are those who wrote the bill and presented it for consideration, as are those who voted for the bill in opposition to the Word of God. You cannot pick and choose which of God's moral traits you embrace. You are either moral as God defines moral, or you are not. To be a moral person who then votes to make into law that which is immoral, removes you from the Path of Righteousness and places you on the path to damnation.

This is what Liberalism and The False Prophet are all about, enacting laws and practices that are in direct opposition to the Laws and the Word of God. Because of Satan's lies and deceptions, even moral people can be fooled. This is why; if you do not understand God's Commandments, and the Teachings of Jesus, then how can you know when you are committing a sin?

God will Judge

*Marriage is honorable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whore mongers and adulterers God will Judge. **Hebrews 13:4***

Let's break this down,

The word **"Defiled"** holds significance. The American Heritage Dictionary defines it as; **to make filthy or dirty; pollute, to debase the pureness or excellence of; to corrupt.**

How does one make dirty, pollute or debase a marriage? One way is by committing Adultery, or an act of Fornication, prior to or after entering into marriage.

I know that in this age, premarital sex is accepted, and anyone, male or female, who refuses to have sex after going out on a date, is looked at as weird, or abnormal, so successful has the False Prophet been in supplanting God's Morality with Satan's immorality. So many reading this and wanting to have God forgive their sins, who have indulged in Fornication, may be saying to themselves, if I have already committed this sin, then how can I ever hope to have God sanctify a marriage I wish to enter into.

Believe In Jesus

*That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. **John 3:15***

The key to understanding the above verse is to understand what it is that Jesus means in these words: **"Whosoever believeth in him,"** where the **"Whosoever,"** refers to **"We the People the Sons and Daughters of Man."** The **"Him"** refers to **God-Jesus**. So the question is, **"What is it that we the Sons of Man need to believe?"**

The following is a short list of those things that you need to believe if you are to give true and correct worship to God the Creator.

Believe in the Resurrection

You must believe God's promise that as Jesus was resurrected from the dead into eternal life, so too will he resurrect his Saints into eternal life. You are a Saint of God if you go through a rebirth of personality from one who is of sin to one who works to keep yourself from sin.

You must believe Jesus in fact was resurrected from the dead by God the Father.

The Word of God is Truth

You must believe that the Word of God is truth, and whenever someone speaks anything that is contrary to the Word of God such as some long held belief you have, you must accept God's Word and reject that long held believe.

Jesus Fulfilled or Brought to Completion

You must believe that the Teachings of Jesus are a fulfillment and a completion of the Law of God, that Jesus took the Ten Commandments which were incomplete and through Jesus' teachings of additional moral imperatives, brought the Ten Commandments to completion.

Believe that Jesus is God's "Only Begotten Son"

*For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. **John 3:16***

The above verse sounds like a repeat of the verse before it, but there is something else that Jesus is teaching us in this verse.

Son of God

You must believe that Jesus is the Son of God, which is to say that Jesus is a flesh and blood Man, born of the woman Mary, but fathered by the God of Creation and not fathered by the man Joseph.

God in the Flesh of a Man

But more than that, Jesus is the Christ, **"God in the flesh of a Man."**

You must believe that Jesus gave his life up to death so that we the Sons of Man could be redeemed unto God. Only through our belief in Jesus and all that Jesus taught can any Man be redeemed.

To Save Not to Condemn

*For God **sent not** his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. **John 3:17***

Before the First Advent of Christ, no Man could have redemption before God. Man was lost in the Sin of Adam, with no path available to be redeemed by God. In the Christ Jesus, this path was made available not just to those who have lived since Jesus, but to all Man even those who lived and died before Jesus. Jesus is the way and the justification in the **hope** of redemption.

Justified In Hope

The Laws of God teach us how not to sin, which is important, **for no sinner shall enter heaven**, but only in the belief in God's Promises, and of the Resurrection of Jesus are we **justified** (not guaranteed) in the **hope** of Salvation.

The Teachings of Jesus are not a condemnation of the Sons of Man, but they are instead a light of understanding as to how God commands that we shape our personal honor, personality and our moral character. If we the Sons and Daughters of Man learn from Jesus and write God's Morality on our hearts, to love God with all our heart, soul and mind, then we will be one with God.

He That Believeth

*He that believeth on him is not condemned; but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. **John 3:18***

To be condemned is to fail to be redeemed, to fail to be worthy of eternal life. God is a moral being, and he commands that we his children be moral as well. God has given us a listing of his own moral imperatives, and it is for us, the Sons of Man, to learn those morals and then embrace them and make them our own morals. Only those who believe this, and act upon this, and do this, have any chance of salvation. Those who fail, or do not even try, are already condemned to eternal death.

Revealing your Sins

*And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. **John 3:19-20***

The **“Light”** is God’s True Word. The **“Light”** is the knowledge found in the diligent study and research of the Words of the Bible, so that you can seek out God’s True Word, even though it is partly hidden by Satan’s Lies.

The **“Darkness”** is ignorance and your reliance on your Blind Faith in accepting the words of others as being the Word of God, without questioning and seeking the truth for yourself.

The most obvious showing of this **“Darkness”** is Satan’s Lie that the Holy Sabbath of God has been moved from the Seventh Day of the week to the First Day of the week. There is no instruction, nor is there commandment in the Bible where God or Jesus tells us that this is so; therefore if God did not speak it then is a lie. If you continue to accept that Sunday is the correct day of the week to observe the Sabbath, then you love the Darkness and hate the Light for the Darkness is Satan’s lies, and the Light is God’s True Word.

Truth cometh to the light

*But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. **John 3:21***

Put simply this all means, if you have sinned and you refuse to accept Christ and the Commandments of God, because to do so you first must acknowledge your sins, and reproach yourself, then you are in opposition to the Word of God.

If you do not see what harm there is, by having sex with someone other than your spouse, and if you can’t see why others, even God, should dictate to you what is right and what is wrong, then you have put yourself in opposition to the Word of God, and unless you repent your sins, you are already condemned to Hell’s Fire.

Crucible of the Soul

God loves us all, and wants all of us to come to him, but first we must prove ourselves worthy. Unlike the angels, which God made perfect right from the start; God has put Man in this imperfect world, with the

lusts and needs of the beasts. I like to refer to this time on Earth, as a **Crucible of the Soul**. Those of us able to be tempered and forged in the heat of Satan's influences, and made pure from it, will be welcomed into Heaven, which is the *house of many mansions*, that Jesus spoke of.

I have often heard it said by those who wish to indulge in immoral behavior, "Who are you to impose your morals upon me?" well I say to that, "these are Gods morals first, and he gave them to me. They have been the standard by which Western Civilization has lived by, for the last 6,000 years, despite Satan's attempts to destroy them. Who are you to think you are special or wiser than God and all who have lived before you?"

John 3:21, above, is the key. Despite your sins, if you repent and look to Christ for guidance, then God will hold your sins **wrought**. The American Heritage dictionary defines the word "**Wrought**" as: **a past tense and a past participle of work.** In other words, it is put in the past, and so long as it remains in the past, and you no longer sin against God's Word, through Christ you will be forgiven.

Jesus and Divorce

Marriage is for Life

*It hath been said, "Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement: But I say unto you, that whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery. **Matthew 5:31-32***

There is another aspect of Jesus words I feel need to be made clear. The one who puts their spouse away in divorce will be an adulterer themselves if they marry again, and they will also cause the one they marry to commit adultery as well. Regardless of what any Civil Law proclaims, when you marry, as far as God is concerned, the marriage is for life, "Until Death do you part."

The words, "saving for the cause of fornication", tells me that a divorce is accepted by God, only when the spouse has committed the sin of Adultery, Fornication, or any of the other sexual acts covered under that Commandment. So unless God should give me cause to believe otherwise, the only time an individual can divorce their spouse, without committing Adultery themselves, is if their spouse was unfaithful to them first.

This verse speaks of the consequence to the woman, but I would suggest that the converse for men is true as well. This also suggests to me, that except for infidelity, God views marriage as a lifelong

commitment. However if the spouse should commit Adultery, God is telling us that the one that has sinned will not cause the other, who has remained faithful in the marriage, to sin should he or she remarry after receiving a divorce.

This also means to me, that if you are divorced, do to your spouse's infidelity, and then you remarry, you do not commit the sin of Adultery when you remarry, nor do you cause your new spouse to commit Adultery. If, however, you were the one that committed Adultery during your marriage, and are divorced, and then remarry, you cause your new spouse to commit Adultery, because of your own sin of adultery.

Liberalism and Adultery

At this time in history, I have witnessed people who get married with the thought in mind that if things don't work out they can always get a divorce later. This mind set is based upon the False Prophet's influence upon civil laws over the last several generations, that adultery and fornication are not sins, but a normal aspect of being human. As I have attempted to make clear in all that God has given me to write, this is contrary to the will of God.

Remember: what Jesus has said in the above verses, **“He that believeth on him is not condemned.”** You must believe the Word of God, else you are condemned already. God's Word tells us that marriage is for life; therefore you must believe the Word of God, regardless of what the civil laws allow.

Jesus and Marriage

The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, “Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?” And he answered and said unto them, “Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, and said for this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.” **Matthew 19:3-6**

In the Old Testament, as written in the laws of Moses, divorces were acceptable, but here is what Jesus had to say about it.

He which made them at the beginning, where the **“HE”** is God, and **“at the beginning”** is the Sixth Day of Creation, which is the day of creation that Man is first placed upon the earth.

Made them male and female, is how God-Jesus defines “**Husband and Wife.**” This definition therefore tells me that “male and male, or female and female” is not as God defines a Married Couple.

For this cause shall a man leave father and mother. When you live in the home of your Father and Mother, you must live under their set of rules, always subject to their wishes and commandments.

Remember: Honor your Mother and Father?

When you get married, you remove yourself from the family that was your Father and Mothers, to enter into a new family of Husband and Wife.

And shall cleave to his wife, therefore in this new family, a man must cling closely, steadfastly and faithfully to his wife, putting her and the new family first and all other loyalties second.

They twain shall be one flesh. The word “**Twain**” means two, but in this context it has a greater meaning. Before marriage, the two were separate individuals, but when they get married they become a family, which is a single entity comprising the total of the two but separate from the family of the Father and Mother.

Marriage is Like Conception

Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. As a separate family they are a couple unto themselves. Think of this like the conception of a child. The seed of the Father has life because of the Father and not of itself. The seed of the Mother has life because of the Mother and not of itself, however when the two come together and bond there is no longer a seed but a new entity that has life of its own, given to it by God at conception, no longer part of the Father and only part of the Mother for the need of substance till birth. When you think of Marriage in this way you can easily see how husband and wife is a new family no longer part of the family of their Fathers and Mothers.

Divorce, Satan's Weapon

What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Just as God tells us that to kill is an act of evil, as in the abortion of an unborn child, so too is it an act of evil for Man to break apart a husband and wife. Those liberal laws enacted by Civil Governments that allow divorce under any reasons other than the only one that God allows a divorce, are in direct opposition to the Law and Will of God, and as such are

evil. All evil has at its foundation the Lies of Satan. In this is shown how Liberalism is the False Prophet and a weapon of Satan, and how Satan uses this weapon to attempt to sway Man away from God's Morality.

Hardness of the Heart

*They say unto him, "Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away? He (Jesus) saith unto them, "Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so. And I say unto you, "Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery." **Matthew 19:7-9***

These above two verses speak of how the husband causes the wife to commit adultery, and any new husband that she gets remarried to. I am compelled to add to this, that the husband that puts his wife away in divorce, when there was no infidelity by the wife, will commit adultery if he remarries, and his new wife will be also committing adultery, even if she is unaware of the wrongful divorce. **You must believe** that marriage is for life and therefore must not be entered into without a moral commitment to a life together.

Your Wedding Vows

One other aspect of marriage needs to be broached, here. When you stand before someone, be it a priest, ordained minister, or some other individual legally authorized to perform the marriage, you make a vow, to your prospective spouse, and to all those present in witness to your marriage. If you make this vow to your spouse to be, as well as those others in presence and to God who will be witness to your marriage, whether you invite him or not, then you commit yourself to the marriage for life.

If you get married with the intent or expectation that if the marriage doesn't work out you can get a divorce later, you are not actually getting married under God's definition of marriage, which means that any sex that you have with this person who God does not recognize as your spouse, is fornication, and a sin.

If you wish to remain obedient to the word of God, then he expects you to keep your vows. If after a time, one or both of you decide that the marriage isn't all that you had hoped, and decide to seek a divorce, keep the following in mind. Marriage is not about having sex without sin. Marriage is about having a friend, companion, and a partner to share your life with, and for you to share their life. The friendship and the emotional bond sealed with trust, is what marriage is all about.

Remember: sex between husband and wife is a gift from God; it was given to bring a physical tie to your spouse that only you two share. When you engage in adultery, you destroy that special sharing as well as the trust. Are having a few moments of physical pleasure really worth losing all of that?

Unmarried Parents

In this time, the early years of the Twenty First Century, there are many, who live together, and have children, but never get legally married. Does this then mean they are both guilty of Fornication? There are some who would say yes, and in the strictest interpretation of the Word of God you do. But if you look at the practices of the Old Testament, there was no formal licensing required for a couple to be married. If the parents of both condoned the relationship, either directly or indirectly by their inaction, then the two became man and wife under God.

As was the case then, today if the parents do not object that no formal wedding or licensing was obtained, then the couple is married just the same. They have chosen each other; they have made a commitment to each other through their actions if not in words, so they are therefore married under God. Once they have children, the children are not bastards, but legal offspring.

My Opinion, You Decide

Of course, this is my opinion; you can form your own opinion from your study of the Bible. It is also my opinion that those who live together without a formal marriage have a phobia of committing to a lifelong relationship, and that they believe that they are always free to walk away from a relationship where there is no marriage.

They also think that they are free of sin, if they chose to engage in an affair with someone else, because the definition of Adultery doesn't apply, which is why God includes the sin of Fornication as part of and included in the Commandment against Adultery. This belief has at its roots in Satan's Lies, and is fraught with so many points of error. If you love each other, and want to live together as man and wife, then you should first get married, under the Law of God even if not under the civil laws. The sin is in engaging in sex outside of marriage. All sins are equal, to kill someone is a sin, to have extramarital sex is a sin, and both remove you from the Grace of God.

Morality of God

The Morality of God, as reflected in the Ten Commandments and fulfilled by the teachings of Jesus, is founded in logic. They do not just instruct us what is and is not tolerated by God, but they also offer a foundation for social unity and peace.

Liberalism, as the religion of the False Prophet, and Satan's weapon, has flourished in Europe and the Americas for several generations now, and if you compare society now to what it was even as little as fifty years ago, a stark difference manifests itself. Liberalism has not made society better, but as everything that is associated with Satan's False Gospel, society is far more decadent and rampant with crime and corruption at all levels of government and in all social levels.

Abortion, the Murder of an unborn child

Thou shalt not kill. Exodus 20:13

Liberalism tells us that a human embryo is just an unviable bio-mass, and is therefore not a human being. As such it is not murder to abort the pregnancy.

Liberalism tells us that a woman has the right to choose if she is to carry a pregnancy to term or to have it aborted.

Liberalism tells us that our body belongs to us, and we therefore have the last say as to what we do with our own bodies.

Liberals have enacted laws that make it legal for women who choose to have the child aborted and then to do so, and anyone that attempts to prevent her from having the abortion is committing a crime and can be arrested and fined. All this is in direct and absolute opposition to the will of God.

The question then comes down to this, is a human embryo a living human being and as such a human baby inside its mother's womb, subject to the same right to life as a child outside of the womb of its mother?

The False Prophet, (Liberalism) says no, it is not human.

Defining a Living Soul

*For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb. **Luke 1:15***

Let's see how God defines when an embryo becomes a living soul. For a Son of Man, life is nothing unless we also have a soul; else all that Man would be is just another animal. Therefore, at what point does God make the son and daughters of Man a living soul?

John the Baptist

In this verse God is instructing us that John the Baptist was filled with the Holy Ghost, while still in his mother's womb. Everything I have read in Holy Scripture tells me that you only receive the Holy Ghost when you have embraced the morality of God and give true and correct worship as God commands. This requires of us, knowledge, brought about from education.

In the above verse, God is telling us, that in the person of John the Baptist, God gave this knowledge to an unborn child. Can you imagine being born in full knowledge of God's Holy Word? Because God tells us this, it is also God's way of showing us that even at conception, Man is a living soul. It is the soul that makes Man in the image of God; therefore the unborn child of John could only receive the Holy Ghost if he already had a soul. This tells me, that all of Man is made a living soul at conception and therefore to take the life of an unborn child is murder, just as taking the life of a child that has been born out of his mother's womb is murder.

Satan Hates Man

Satan hates Man, and he will do everything he can to cause Man to break the Laws of God. If Satan can convince you that you have the right to decide to carry an unwanted pregnancy to term or not, then Satan has won. The Law of God is clear, **"Thou Shalt Not Kill,"** so for you to do so in having your child aborted, you fall short of the Grace of God. If you are not in the Grace of God, then you are damned to Hell's Fire.

Still in the Womb

And Mary arose in those days, and went into the hill country with haste, into a city of Juda; and entered into the house of Zacharias, and saluted Elisabeth. And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard

the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost: Luke 1:39-41

What these verses are telling me is that God recognizes the unborn child of John the Baptist and that of the newly conceived child of Jesus as a living human being. At the sound of Mary's voice, who herself was conceived of Jesus, the unborn child of John leaped in the womb of his mother. In that John is no different than you and I or our children, then this also tells me that God considers all conceived embryo as being a living soul, (human), right from the instant of conception.

Consider this: *"The babe leaped in her womb."* These words are telling me that the unborn child that was John the Baptist recognized the newly conceived child of Jesus as being the God of Creation in the flesh of a man. This then tells me that God is telling us that an unborn child is not just an unviable bio-mass but a living human being. That God recognizes this to be so, then should we who love God do no less?

In that God considers this to be so, for the woman to take the life of another human being (her unborn child) is to put her in violation of the Commandment of God, *Thou Shalt Not Kill*. **The woman** who agrees to have her child aborted has committed murder. **The doctor** who performs the abortion is committing murder. **The medical personnel** involved with the preparation of the abortion are committing murder. **The members of the legislators** involved with writing the bill allowing for abortion and who then offered it up for vote committed murder. **The members of the legislators** who voted yes for this bill committed murder. **The Governor of the State** that signed this bill into law committed murder. **All citizens** who agreed with the legality of this law commit murder every time an abortion is performed.

Though Satan, through Liberalism, tells us that our bodies belong to each of us, to do with as is our pleasure, as I have shown above, Jesus tells us a much different story.

Feed the Church of God

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the Church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. Acts 20:28

In this verse the Apostle Paul is speaking to the leaders of the Christian Churches. Paul is warning those leaders to feed the flock, which are the people of the congregation that make up the Church. This means to feed God's True Word to the people, so as to sustain and continue the Church of God in the Ways of God.

Paul is also informing all who read these words, which Jesus paid for the congregations of the Church of God with his own blood when he was crucified on the cross. As such these people no longer belong to themselves but to God, bought and paid for. This tells me, that the woman's body does not belong to her, and it is not her right to decide what she will do with it.

Not only is aborting an unborn child murder, so too is thinking yourself above God a sin.

God's Promise of Salvation

*When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the Lord thy God, **and shalt be obedient unto his voice**; he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them. **Deuteronomy 4:30-31***

You belong to God, and you must **be obedient to his Word** and to all his Ways, else you fall short of his gift of Eternal Life and will only know eternal death.

It is the False Prophet's Liberal policies established throughout the world that have made abortion legal under civil law, but only God can change the Laws of God. If you love God, it does not matter what civil law says, you must uphold God's Ways, else you are condemned to damnation.

Founded in God's Morality

The following is a list of God's moral imperatives as found in the Ten Commandments as well as those taught by Jesus. The last Six of the Ten Commandments are God's minimum moral traits that you and I must live our lives by if we want any chance of entering Heaven, those moral traits taught by Jesus bring to fulfillment the Laws of God, and thereby reveal the fullness of who God is, through his Personality, Personal Honor and his Moral Character. All of the following are under attack by Satan through the False Prophet which Satan has established to pick up where the anti-Christ left off.
